Tuition Fee	To be waived for student from partner universities & from UMAP member universities who take the maximum of 5 courses (extra expenses can be expected for possible workshop and site visit depending on curriculum requirement)
<b>Fees: student is required to pay SPU on his/ her arrival</b>	
Non-Thai student fee	THB 10,000/ semester (THB 20,000/ two semesters)
Matriculation Fee	THB 10,200/ semester

Insurance	Student is advised to purchase medical insurance from home country and make sure the policy terms are applicable in Thailand. Otherwise, without proof of insurance coverage from student's home country; THB 5,000 is required for health insurance, and THB 200 is required for accident insurance with SPU.

<b>Requirements</b>	
GPA	at least 2.5
Language proficiency test score	The satisfactory tests score are 176 for TOEFL-CBT, 63 for IBT and 500 for paper/or 5.0 for IELTS/ or 600 for TOEIC *Alternatively, the recommendation letter from the home institution to confirm student's language ability with good command of English can be accepted.
VISA	After the application is accepted and approved, the official letter of acceptance and other supporting documents (upon request) will be sent to the student for visa application at the local Thai Embassy/ Consulate. Exchange student is advised to apply for Thai Education visa (Non-Immigration Visa - category ED: Non-ED) before enter Thailand.
<b>Accommodation</b>	
Type of housing (e.g. Dormitory, Apartment)	Off campus accommodation within walking distance. Two students per standard room (additional charge may be applied for single occupancy of a room). Office of International Relations can assist student in finding proper accommodation that suits to student's interest.
